



Flag of the Philippines - Tatlong Bituin at Isang Araw ("Three Stars and a Sun") Adopted on June 12, 1898. Designed by Emilio Aguinaldo.

Ahorizontal bicolor of blue over red, with a white equilateral triangle at the hoist containing three, 5-pointed gold stars at its vertices, and an 8-rayed gold sun at its center. A unique feature of this flag is its ability to indicate a state of war if it is displayed with the red side on top.
